Camp begins at Camp Morningstar in Angelus Oaks on Sunday, June 26th, with camp check-in from 3:30-5:00 p.m. A worship service will be held at 5:00 p.m. for campers and parents. Dinner will be served at 6:00 p.m. for campers only.

- All medication will be stored with camp nurse during check-in
- Funds for snack bar to be "banked" in advance or at check-in. Snack bar is a no cash system.

Camp ends on Saturday, July 2nd with check out for campers from 10 -11 a.m. **Campers MUST checkout before they leave on Saturday morning. All campers are required to be off camp premises by 11:00 a.m.**

Ages/Grades

Campers who have **completed** grades **3 -12** are welcome to register.

Activities

The camp schedule will include a spiritual focus of devotions and Bible classes, as well as many activities like crafts, swimming, hiking, athletic events, campfires and talent shows. Registered campers will have an opportunity to select craft option in May.
