Camp begins Sunday June 28th, with camp registration from 3:30-5:00 p.m. A worship service will be held at 5:00 p.m. for campers and parents. Dinner will be served at 6:00 p.m. for campers only.

Camp ends on Saturday, July 4th with check out for campers from 9:30-11 a.m. **Campers MUST checkout before they leave on Saturday morning. All campers are required to be off camp premises by 11:00 a.m.**

Campers who have **completed** grades **3 -12** are welcome to register.

Dress & Conduct

Our summer camp is designed to provide a clean, wholesome and beneficial environment. We strive to maintain a spiritual atmosphere according to principles found in the Bible, not be a distraction to others. Each camper will be required to respect the instructions of the counselors and follow the rules of the camp including:
